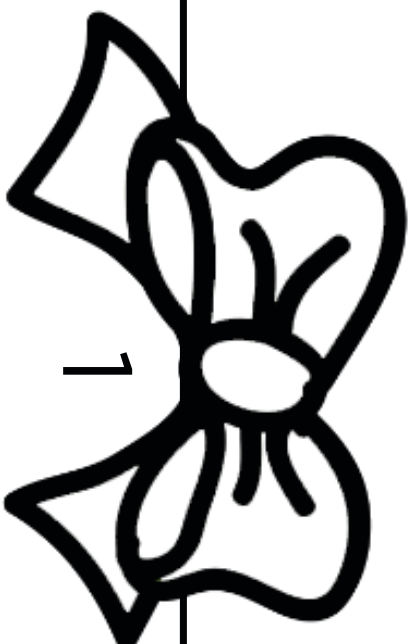


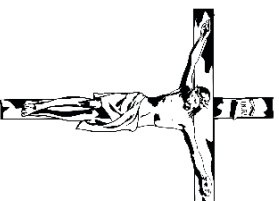
## CHARACTERISTICS OF JESUS' LOVE - POSTER 1

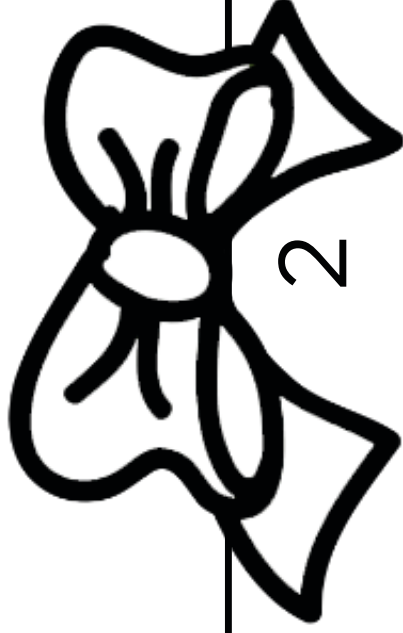
### GIFT-OF-SELF (PART 2)

Describe a time that you had to choose to give a gift-of-self.

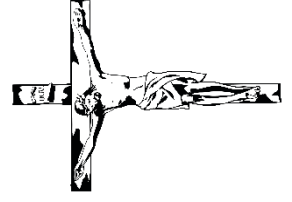


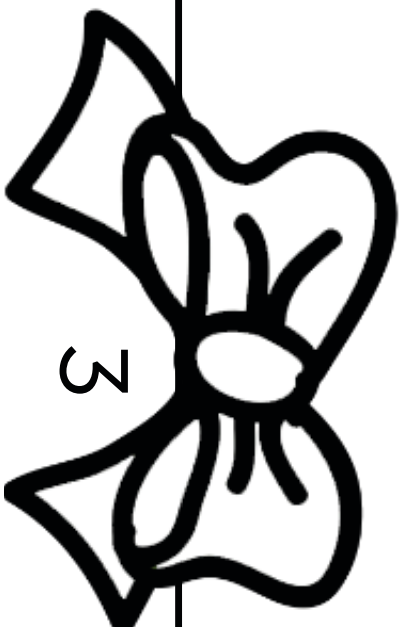


Jesus gives his entire life on the cross. This meant that he gave up every drop of sweat and blood from his body for us.

It is unlikely that we will die for someone else, but we can sacrifice other things for someone else. Describe a time that you sweated or bled while helping someone (like your teammates).

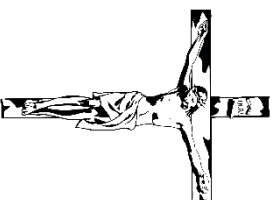


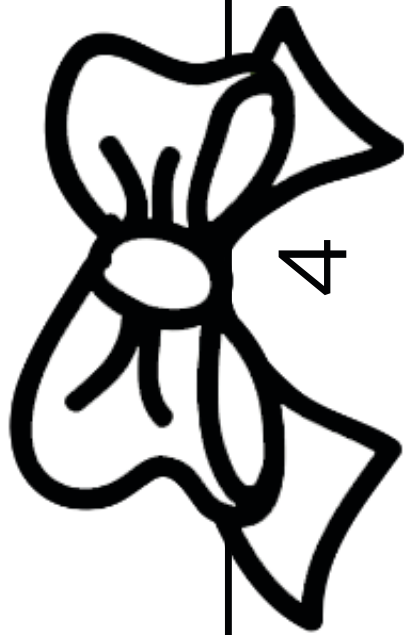


Jesus never stops loving us. He never gives up on us. His love is faithful for all eternity.
