THEME: MAN OF CONCUPISCENCE

SOW THE SEED



Dear Parents,

In this Theology of the Body (TOB) unit, your child will dive deeply into the theme **Man of Concupiscence**.

In this unit, your child will be introduced to the nature of sin and its effects. Sin not only impacts the sinner but also their relationship with God, others and the world. Reflecting on what happened to Adam and Eve in original sin helps us to reflect on our own lives, because the pattern of sin and redemption is the same for us.

In the next few lessons, your child will read and ponder the meaning of Genesis 2:15-17 and 3:1-7. In this reading, your child will hear the story of Adam and Eve and the lies of the serpent. They will listen as Eve is convinced of these lies and chooses to doubt the gifts that God has given them. They will learn that sin brings brokenness into our lives. When man breaks his covenant with God, he breaks his relationship to himself, others and the world. We encourage you to read the lesson in the Common Place Book for a deeper understanding.

As the lessons unfold, your child will play a game called “Minefield” and analyze excerpts from “The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe” to help them connect this understanding of the effects of sin to their own lives. The class will also participate in class discussion to dive more deeply into their understanding, and ability to make reasonable connections.
