Briefly describe what you have done this school year TO DEEPEN THE IMMERSION OF TEACHERS AND STAFF IN TOB

This school year we became a Theology of the Body campus and we have implemented a variety of things in order to deepen immersion. We began by hanging two banners in our school, one in the main hallway of our school and one in the gymnasium. Secondly, we purchased enough copies for staff members of the Rosary meditations published by Ruah Woods Press, *On a Mission to Love*. Additionally, we have funded many professional development opportunities for our staff members to further educate them on the Theology of the Body mission and how to incorporate the language in our school.

Briefly describe what you have done this school year TO EDUCATE STUDENTS IN TOB IN EVERY GRADE

With the purchase of the *On a Mission to Love* books, we have incorporated a school wide praying of the rosary each and every Tuesday. We had a very generous community member donate enough Rosaries for every student to use while doing this. We also purchased the Theology of the Body textbooks for our religion teachers to use during instruction. Fully integrating the TOB curriculum into our school was a goal drafted in our 2016-2021 strategic plan, and we feel we have successfully planted the seed with our students that they are in fact unique, created in the image and likeness of God, and for a special purpose.

Briefly describe what you have done this school year TO CREATIVELY PROMOTE TOB VISION AND CULTURE THROUGHOUT YOUR ORGANIZATION

We have incorporated an opportunity for every student to go to Church for Adoration of our Lord once monthly. Saint Pope John Paul the II says, "The body ... is capable of making visible what is invisible: the spiritual and the divine. It has been created to transfer into the visible reality of the world, the mystery hidden from eternity in God, and thus to be a sign of it" (Theology of the Body, 19:4).

And finally, we had a dynamic guest speaker come and speak to our junior high students during religion class about his journey to the Catholic faith and how he found joy and peace in his life after 42 years through the Catholic Church.
