
2) Read Figure 1 and Figure 2. Answer the question below.








3)	Read John 13:34. What is the new commandment that Jesus reveals at the






4) Read John 15:13. What does Jesus tell us is the greatest expression of love?






7) Read Matthew 26:26-28.


Write a short prayer thanking Jesus for the gift of the Eucharist.


